An Act to increase the penalties imposed by the Elizabeth II, Inclosed Lands Protection Act, 1901–1939; for No. 14, 1964 this purpose to amend that Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 20th April, 1964.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Inclosed Lands Short title Protection (Amendment) Act, 1964".
- (2) The Inclosed Lands Protection Act, 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Inclosed Lands Protection Act, 1901-1964.
- 2. The Inclosed Lands Protection Act, 1901-1939, is Amendment of Act No. 33, 1901.
