## **State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) Amendment (Ivanhoe Estate) 2017**

Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979

### **1 Name of Policy**

This Policy is *State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) Amendment (Ivanhoe Estate) 2017*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Policy commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Maps**

The maps adopted by *State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) 2011* are amended or replaced, as the case requires, by the maps approved by the Minister on the making of this Policy.

### **4 Repeal of Policy**

- (1) This Policy is repealed on the day following the day on which this Policy commences.
- (2) The repeal of this Policy does not, because of the operation of sections 5 (6) and 30 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, affect any amendment made by this Policy.

### **5 Amendment of State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) 2011**

#### **Schedule 2 State significant development—identified sites**

Omit clause 10 (including the note). Insert instead:

#### **10 Development at NSW Land and Housing Corporation Sites**

- (1) Development on land identified as a NSW Land and Housing Corporation Site on the State Significant Development Sites Map if the development:
  - (a) is carried out by or on behalf of the NSW Land and Housing Corporation, and
  - (b) has a capital investment value of more than \$20 million.
- (2) For the purposes of subclause (1), land identified as being within Ivanhoe Estate on the State Significant Development Sites Map is identified as a NSW Land and Housing Corporation Site.
