1 Name of plan

This plan is Byron Local Environmental Plan 2014 (Amendment No 37).

2 Commencement

This plan commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Land to which plan applies

This plan applies to Lot 452, DP 48493, Lighthouse Road, Byron Bay.

4 Amendment of Byron Local Environmental Plan 2014

(1) Schedule 2 Exempt development

Insert "in Mullumbimby" after "facilities" in the matter relating to Temporary community facilities, heading.

(2) Schedule 2

Insert in alphabetical order—

Temporary community facilities in Byron Bay

- (1) This clause applies to Lot 452, DP 48493, Lighthouse Road, Byron Bay.
- (2) Must include no more than 2 buildings.
- (3) Must not have a gross floor area of more than 85m².
- (4) An evacuation diagram with the following information must be displayed in each building—
 - (a) directions to evacuate the site,
 - (b) contact details for emergency services, including for a bush fire, flood or other natural disaster.
- (5) Must conform to the specifications and requirements of *Planning for Bush Fire Protection*, ISBN 978 0 646 99126 9, dated 9 November 2019.
- (6) Must not remain on the land after 28 February 2025.
