Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 to the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*. Schedule 1 lists plants and drugs that are prohibited for the purposes of the Act. The proposed amendment adds the drug Ketamine to the list.

This Regulation is made under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*, including sections 44 and 45 (the general regulation-making power).
