Courts and Crimes Legislation Further Amendment Act 2008 No 107


JAMES JACOB SPIGELMAN, Lieutenant-Governor

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Courts and Crimes Legislation Further Amendment Act 2008* that abolish Wardens' Courts and that effect the transfer to the Land and Environment Court of the jurisdiction currently conferred on wardens and Wardens' Courts by the *Mining Act 1992* and the *Petroleum (Onshore) Act 1991*.
