Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Motor Vehicle Repairs Act 1980*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Motor Vehicle Repairs Regulation 2011* to increase the fees payable in relation to the licensing of repair businesses and the certification of repair tradespersons under the *Motor Vehicle Repairs Act 1980*.

The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (rounded to the nearest dollar).

This Regulation is made under the *Motor Vehicle Repairs Act 1980*, including sections 16 (Application for licence), 21 (Duration of licence fee and annual licence fee), 24 (Grant of tradesperson's certificate) and 89 (the general regulation-making power).
