- (a) 31 July 2015 as the day on which Schedules 1 [1]–[12] and 2 to that Act commence, and
- (b) 30 September 2015 as the day on which Schedules 1 [13], 4 [6] and 6 to that Act commence.

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, and the regulations made under that Act, that relate to:

- (a) offences, penalties and enforcement powers (which commence on 31 July 2015), and
- (b) the offence of providing false or misleading information in connection with a planning matter and the disclosure of political donations and gifts (which commence on 30 September 2015).
