
Inclosed Lands, Crimes and Law Enforcement Legislation Amendment (Interference) Act 2016 No 7

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the *Inclosed Lands, Crimes and Law Enforcement Legislation Amendment (Interference) Act 2016* except for the amendments to the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Act 2002* which confer additional search and seizure powers in certain circumstances and remove limitations on the exercise of police powers to give directions in public places in the case of demonstrations, protests, processions and organised assemblies.
