Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to amend proclamations creating new council areas with respect to the continuation of pre-existing rating and charges variations and to provide for the payment of fees to any Administrator of a new council who exercises functions relating to a county council.

1 Name of Proclamation

1.3 Local Government (Council Amalgamations) Proclamation 2016

[1] Clause 12 Administrators for new councils

Insert after clause 12 (5):

- (5A) An Administrator who exercises any functions referred to in clause 8 is to be paid a fee for the exercise of those functions that is determined by the Minister and paid from the funds of the county council.

[2] Clause 26 Calculation of notional general income for rating purposes

Omit “, but only for the 2016/2017 rating year” from clause 26 (2).
