Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments made by the *Parole Legislation Amendment Act 2017* relating to the following:

- (a) the imposition of a community safety test for determining whether to release an adult offender on parole,
- (b) enabling the Governor to exercise the prerogative of mercy by making a parole order in respect of an adult offender,
- (c) imposing a duty on health service providers to provide information about adult offenders' compliance with certain conditions of parole relating to obtaining health services,
- (d) the provision of information to registered victims,
- (e) savings and transitional provisions.
