Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Roads Regulation 2008* to continue in force, for a further 3 years, a provision declaring the Barangaroo Delivery Authority to be the roads authority for certain public roads in or in the vicinity of Barangaroo.

This Regulation is made under the *Roads Act 1993*, including sections 7 (3) and 264 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
