Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Passenger Transport (General) Regulation 2017* to appoint persons who are employed by, or contractors of, operators of a public passenger service as authorised officers for the purposes of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*. Those persons are subject to the control and direction of Transport for NSW.

This Regulation is made under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*, including sections 46W and 63 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Passenger Transport (General) Amendment (Authorised Officers) Regulation 2017*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Passenger Transport (General) Regulation 2017

(1) Clause 239 Authorised officers

Insert after clause 239 (1) (h):

- (i) persons who are employed by, or are contractors of, any other operator of a public passenger service and who provide services for the purposes of that public passenger service.

(2) Clause 239 (2)

Omit “(g) or (h)”. Insert instead “(g), (h) or (i)”.
