

Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Regulation 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Act 1963*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake, with minor changes, the *Long Service Leave* (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Regulation 2016, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2021 by the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989, section 10(2).

Section 3(2C) of the *Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Act 1963* provides that, for the purpose of paying long service leave, bonuses do not form part of a worker's ordinary pay if the worker's ordinary pay exceeds the amount prescribed by the regulations. This Regulation prescribes that amount.

This Regulation is made under the *Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Act 1963*, including sections 3(2C) and 15 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989, namely—

- (a) matters of a machinery nature, and
- (b) matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Regulation 2021.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation repeals and replaces the *Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Regulation 2016*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2021 by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, section 10(2).

3 Definition

In this Regulation—

the Act means the Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Act 1963.

Note. The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Regulation.

4 Calculating ordinary pay for payment of annual leave—bonuses

For the purposes of section 3(2C) of the Act, the prescribed annual amount of a worker's ordinary pay is the greater of the following—

- (a) \$144,000,
- (b) the amount calculated, from time to time, in accordance with Chapter 2, regulation 2.13 of the *Fair Work Regulations 2009* of the Commonwealth.

Note. Section 3(2C) of the Act provides that, for the purpose of paying long service leave, bonuses do not form part of a worker's ordinary pay if the worker's annual ordinary pay exceeds the amount prescribed by the regulations. This clause prescribes that amount.

5 Repeal and savings

- (1) The Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Regulation 2016 is repealed.
- (2) Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Long Service Leave (Metalliferous Mining Industry) Regulation 2016*, had effect under that Regulation continues to have effect under this Regulation.
