Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following regulation under the *Gaming Machines Act 2001*.

Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Gaming Machines Regulation 2019* to prescribe a maximum number of gaming machine entitlements for the *Gaming Machines Act 2001*, section 10(1) to lower the overall State cap on those entitlements.

Section 3 may be made under a Henry VIII provision because the amendment of the *Gaming Machines Regulation 2019* has the effect of amending the matter set out in the *Gaming Machines Act 2001*, section 10(1).
