Act No 51, 2003

An Act to amend the *Education Act 1990* to require candidates for the School Certificate to be tested for computing skills. [Assented to 23 October 2003]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Education Amendment (Computing Skills) Act 2003.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.
