Act No 33, 2015

An Act to amend the *State Arms, Symbols and Emblems Act 2004* to recognise the fish fossil *Mandageria fairfaxi* as a State emblem. [Assented to 22 October 2015]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the State Arms, Symbols and Emblems Amendment (Fossil Emblem) Act 2015.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.
