ELECTRICITY ACT 1945—REGULATION

(Electricity (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1996)

Citation

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Electricity (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1996.

Commencement

2. This Regulation is taken to have commenced on 1 March 1996.

Continued operation of Electricity (Accounts) Regulation 1994 from 1.3.96 to 30.6.96

3. (1) This clause has effect for the period beginning on 1 March 1996 and ending on 30 June 1996.

(2) The provisions of the Electricity (Accounts) Regulation 1994 relating to:

- (a) the calculation of charges for electricity supplied; and
- (b) the rendering of accounts for electricity supplied,

continue to have effect as if that Regulation had not been repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to continue in force, for a transitional period, the provisions of the Electricity (Accounts) Regulation 1994 relating to the calculation of electricity charges and the rendering of accounts for electricity. That Regulation has been repealed by the Energy Services Corporations Act

This Regulation is made under the Electricity Act 1945, including section 37 (the general regulation making power) and clause 1 of Schedule 11 (savings and transitional regulations).
