## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake, with no significant changes of substance, the provisions of the *Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Regulation 1992*.

The new Regulation comprises matter of a machinery nature, namely the particulars to be included in mortgages of sheep, cattle or horses for the purposes of section 13 of the *Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Act 1898*.

This Regulation is made under the *Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Act 1898*, including section 21 (the general regulation making power).

This Regulation is made in connection with the staged repeal of subordinate legislation under the *Subordinate Legislation Act* 1989.

# Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Regulation 1998

#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Regulation 1998*.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 June 1998.

#### 3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Act 1898.

### 4 Particulars to be included in stock mortgages

For the purposes of section 13 of the Act, the following particulars are prescribed:

- (a) the date of the mortgage,
- (b) the full names of the mortgagor and mortgagee,
- (c) the consideration or the amount of the loan,
- (d) the number and description of, and the brand or other distinctive mark on, the sheep, cattle or horses being mortgaged,
- (e) the place where the sheep, cattle or horses are being kept and the name of the manager of that place.

#### 5 Repeal

(1) The Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgages Regulation 1992 is repealed.

Any act, matter or thing that had effect under the *Liens on Crops and Wool and Stock Mortgagees Regulation 1992* immediately before the commencement of this Regulation is taken to have effect under this Regulation.
