

# **Air Transport Regulation 2000**

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake, without any changes in substance, the provisions of the *Air Transport Regulation 1994*. The new Regulation merely deals with the manner in which licence fees under section 7 of the *Air Transport Act 1964* are paid.

This Regulation is made under the *Air Transport Act 1964*, including sections 7 and 13 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation relates to matters of a machinery nature.

This Regulation is made in connection with the staged repeal of statutory rules under Part 3 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

## **Air Transport Regulation 2000**

#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Air Transport Regulation 2000.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 2000.

#### 3 Notes

The explanatory note does not form part of this Regulation.

#### 4 Licence fees

A licence fee payable under section 7 of the Air Transport Act 1964:

- (a) must be paid within 30 days after the end of the month for which it is payable, and
- (b) must be accompanied by a duly completed return in a form approved by the Air Transport Council.

#### 5 Repeal

The Air Transport Regulation 1994 is repealed.
