Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the whole of the State as the area to which the *Drug and Alcohol Treatment Act 2007* applies and to provide for official visitors to visit each treatment centre at least once each calendar month.

This Regulation is made under the *Drug and Alcohol Treatment Act 2007*, including sections 4 (1), 29 (7) and 55 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Drug and Alcohol Treatment Regulation 2012.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 4 September 2012 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Regulation: *the Act* means the *Drug and Alcohol Treatment Act* 2007.

4 Area where Act applies

For the purposes of section 4 (1) of the Act, the whole of the State is the area prescribed.

5 Regular inspections of treatment centres

For the purposes of section 29 (7) of the Act, an official visitor must visit each treatment centre at least once each calendar month.
