Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006.*

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake the provisions of the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2007*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2014 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*. In particular, this Regulation prescribes bamboo and any plant that is a vine as trees, within the meaning of the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006*.

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act* 1989, namely matters of a machinery nature, direct repeals and matters of a savings or transitional nature.

This Regulation is made under the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006*, including sections 3 (1) and 20 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2014*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation repeals and replaces the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours)* Regulation 2007, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2014 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006.

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Prescribed plants

For the purposes of the definition of *tree* in section 3 (1) of the Act, bamboo and any plant that is a vine are prescribed.

5 Repeal and savings

- (1) The *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2007* is repealed.
- (2) Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2007*, had effect under that Regulation continues to have effect under this Regulation.
