

# NSW Self Insurance Corporation Regulation 2015

under the

NSW Self Insurance Corporation Act 2004

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *NSW Self Insurance Corporation Act 2004*.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to authorise the appointed directors of the board of Insurance and Care NSW as a class of persons to whom the NSW Self Insurance Corporation may delegate any of its functions. This Regulation is made under the *NSW Self Insurance Corporation Act 2004*, including paragraph (b) of the definition of *authorised person* in section 9 (2) and section 13 (the general regulation-making power). This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature and matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

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#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the NSW Self Insurance Corporation Regulation 2015.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

#### 3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the NSW Self Insurance Corporation Act 2004.

#### 4 Delegation to authorised persons

The appointed directors of the ICNSW Board (within the meaning of the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015*) are authorised as a class of persons for the purposes of section 9 of the Act.
