LICENSED PUBLICANS. An Act to enlarge the time for the granting of Licenses in pursuance of an Act intituled
“*An Act to regulate the granting of Licenses for the Sale of Spirits Ale Beer and other Liquors in New South Wales and Van Diemen’s Land respectively.*” [22nd February, 1825.]

Preamble. WHEREAS it is necessary to enlarge the time for the granting of Licenses in pursuance of an Act in such case made and provided Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Council that it shall be lawful for the Justices of the Peace in Quarter Sessions or by special appointment assembled on or before Thursday the third day of March next ensuing to grant Certificates according to the form and effect in the said Act mentioned and in the same manner as if the same had been granted on the nineteenth day of this instant month of February.
