LICENSED PUBLICANS.

An Act for prolonging for a certain period the Term of all Licenses for keeping Public-houses which were granted in the year 1829. [15th March, 1830.]

Preamble.

Prolonging for a certain period the public-house licenses granted in 1829.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Governor and Council passed in the seventh year of the reign of His present Majesty intituled "*An Act for repealing the Laws now in force relative to the licensing and regulating of Public-houses and for the better regulating and granting of Licenses for the Sale of Ale Beer Wine Spirits and other Liquors in New South Wales in future*" it is among other things enacted That from and after the commencement of the said Act no person or persons whatsoever shall sell or retail any ale beer wine cyder brandy rum or any other strong fermented or spirituous liquors in New South Wales in less quantity than five gallons without first obtaining a License which shall be valid for one year or until the next licensing day and no longer And whereas it is expedient to prolong the term for which all Licenses were granted in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales by and with the advice of the Legislative Council That all Licenses for keeping public-houses which were granted in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine and which were in force on the first day of the present month of March shall be and the same are hereby declared to be and to continue to be in full force until the thirty-first day of March instant next or until such other day as shall hereafter be by some Law or Ordinance to be passed for such purpose limited and appointed for the commencement of Licenses for the present year And it shall be lawful for all persons holding such Licenses on the said first day of this month to sell and retail and to continue to sell and retail ale beer wine cyder brandy rum and all other strong fermented

fermented or spirituous liquors in virtue of such Licenses until the said thirty-first day of March instant or until such other day as shall hereafter be limited and appointed as aforesaid any thing contained in the said recited Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

2. And be it further enacted That no person who held a License to keep a public-house on the said first day of the present month of March shall be chargeable with violating any of the provisions of the said recited Act in consequence of his or her having sold or retailed ale beer wine cyder brandy rum or other strong fermented or spirituous liquors between the said first day of this instant month of March and the said thirty-first day of the same or such other day as shall be hereafter limited and appointed as aforesaid for the commencement of Licenses for the present year any thing in the said recited Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
