ROBBERS AND
HOUSEBREAKERS.

An Act further to continue an Act of the Governor with the Advice of the Legislative Council passed in the Eleventh Year of His late Majesty intituled “*An Act to suppress Robbery and Housebreaking and the harbouring of Robbers and Housebreakers.*” [8th April, 1834.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed by the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council in the eleventh year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth intituled “*An Act to suppress Robbery and Housebreaking and the harbouring of Robbers and Housebreakers*” to continue and be in force for two years from the passing and publication thereof and whereas by an Act of the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council passed in the second year of the reign of His present Majesty intituled “*An Act to continue for Two Years an Act of the Governor with the advice of the Legislative Council passed in the eleventh year of the reign of His late Majesty intituled ‘An Act to suppress Robbery and Housebreaking and the ‘harbouring of Robbers and Housebreakers’*” after reciting that the said recited Act would expire on the twenty-first day of April one thousand

thousand eight hundred and thirty-two and that it was expedient to continue the said Act for a limited time it was enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council That the said Act should be and the same was thereby continued for two years from and after the said twenty-first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two and whereas the said Act will expire on the twenty-first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four and it is expedient that the said Act should be further continued for a limited time Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council That the said first recited Act shall be and the same is hereby continued from and after the said twenty-first day of April until the thirty-first day of August in this present year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four.
