JURY TRIALS.

WHEREAS an Act of the Governor and Council of New South Preamble.
 Wales was passed in the second year of the reign of His
 present Majesty King William the Fourth intituled “*An Act for 2 Gul. IV. No. 3.
 regulating the constitution of Juries and for Trial of Issues in
 certain cases in the Supreme Court of New South Wales*” which said
 Act was by a certain other Act of the said Governor and Council
 passed in the fourth year of His said Majesty intituled “*An Act 4 Gul. IV. No. 12.
 to continue for a limited time an Act of the Governor and Council
 of New South Wales intituled ‘An Act for regulating the consti-
 tution of Juries and for the Trial of Issues in certain cases in the
 Supreme Court of New South Wales and to make further provision
 for Trial by Jury in Criminal Cases in the said Colony’*” continued
 until the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and thirty-
 five And whereas the said first recited Act was by a certain other Act
 of the said Governor and Council passed in the fifth year of the reign
 of His said Majesty intituled “*An Act to continue for a limited time 5 Gul. IV. No. 25.
 an Act of the Governor and Council of New South Wales intituled
 ‘An Act for regulating the constitution of Juries and for the Trial
 of Issues in certain cases in the Supreme Court of New South
 Wales and to make further provision for Trial by Jury’*” further
 continued until the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty-six And whereas the said first recited Act was by a certain
 other Act of the said Governor and Council passed in the sixth year
 of the reign of His said Majesty intituled “*An Act further to continue 6 Gul. IV. No. 15.
 for a limited time an Act intituled ‘An Act for regulating the con-
 stitution of Juries and for Trial of Issues in certain cases in the
 Supreme Court of New South Wales and to make further provision
 for Trial by Jury’*” further continued until the thirtieth day of
 June one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven and it is expedient
 further to continue the said first recited Act as hereinafter provided
 Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South 2 Gul. IV. No. 3 con-
 tinued until 30th June 1838.
 Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council thereof That the
 said first recited Act passed in the second year of the reign of His
 said Majesty as altered and amended by any of the said three last
 recited Acts shall be and the same is hereby continued in force from
 and after the said thirtieth day of June next until the thirtieth day
 of June one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight.
