FEMALE OFFENDERS. An Act to repeal so much of an Act intituled
“ *An Act to abolish the transportation of Female Convicts and to provide for the more effectual punishment of Female Offenders within the Colony of New South Wales*” as authorizes the confinement of any Female Offender in a Dark Cell. [29th June, 1841.]

Preamble. WHEREAS by an Act of the Governor and Council of New South Wales passed in the third year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria intituled “ *An Act to abolish the transportation of Female Convicts and to provide for the more effectual punishment of Female Offenders within the Colony of New South Wales*” it was amongst other things enacted that female offenders might in certain cases be punished by confinement in the dark cells of any gaol or factory duly appointed for the custody of female offenders and whereas it is expedient to repeal so much of the said recited Act as authorizes the punishment of female offenders by confinement in the dark cells of any such gaol or factory Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice of the Legislative Council thereof That from and after the passing of this Act so much of the said recited Act as authorizes the punishment of female offenders by confinement in the dark cells of any gaol or factory duly appointed for the custody of female offenders shall be and the same is hereby repealed accordingly and that nothing in the said recited Act contained shall authorize the confinement of any female offender in a dark cell.
