IMPORTED ORES—
TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FROM DUTY.

An Act to exempt from Duty for a limited time Metallic Ores imported into New South Wales. [8th November, 1845.]

Preamble. **W**HEREAS it is expedient to exempt for a limited time Metallic Ores imported into this Colony from the duty of Customs now payable thereon. Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That during the continuance of this Act all Metallic Ores imported into the said Colony or entered inwards from the bonded warehouses thereof shall be exempted from the duty of Customs now payable thereon anything contained in any Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

Commencement and duration of Act. 2. And be it enacted That this Act shall commence and take effect from and after the passing thereof and shall thenceforth continue in force for two years.
