

No. XVII.**An Act to amend the Laws incorporating the Town of Melbourne. [Reserved—30th October, 1846.]****MELBOURNE
INCORPORATION
AMENDMENT.**

WHEREAS by an Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of New South Wales passed in the eighth year of the reign of Her present Majesty intituled “*An Act to amend an Act passed in the sixth year of the reign of Her present Majesty intituled ‘An Act to incorporate the Inhabitants of the Town of Melbourne’*” it was enacted that from and after the passing of the said recited Act the Town of Melbourne should consist of the two portions of land which are defined in the Schedule to the said recited Act annexed marked A And whereas it is expedient to alter and amend so much of the said recited Act as relates to the boundaries of South Melbourne (part of the said Town of Melbourne) and otherwise to alter and amend the laws incorporating the Town of Melbourne and to make other provisions in lieu thereof Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That so much of the said recited Act as provides that South Melbourne (part of the said Town of Melbourne) should consist of the portion of land in the Schedule marked A to the said recited Act annexed secondly defined shall be from henceforth and the same is hereby repealed.

2. And be it enacted That from and after the passing of this Act so much of the said Town of Melbourne as is known or distinguished by the name of South Melbourne shall consist of the portion of land defined in the Schedule to this Act annexed.

3. And be it enacted That nothing in this Act contained shall affect or alter the Wards of the said Town of Melbourne or the boundaries thereof as described in the Schedule B to the said recited Act annexed but that all and every the enactments and provisions of the said recited Act except as the same are expressly repealed and altered by this Act shall remain and be in full force and effect in the same manner to all intents and purposes as if the portion of land defined in the said Schedule hereto annexed had been defined and described in the said Schedule marked A to the said recited Act annexed as the portion or boundaries of South Melbourne aforesaid.

4. And whereas it is expedient to repeal the sixty-third section of the Act of the said Governor and Council intituled “*An Act to incorporate the Inhabitants of the Town of Melbourne*” and so much of the third section of the Act of the said Governor and Council passed in the seventh year of Her present Majesty intituled “*An Act to indemnify and render valid the acts of certain Justices of the Peace for the Territory of New South Wales and to enable Territorial Justices of the Peace to act as such under certain limitations within the boundaries of the City of Sydney and Town of Melbourne respectively*” as relates to the Town of Melbourne and the thirty-first section of the Act of the said Governor and Council passed in the eighth year of Her present Majesty intituled “*An Act to amend an Act passed in the sixth year of Her present Majesty intituled ‘An Act to incorporate the Inhabitants of the Town of Melbourne’*” Be it therefore enacted That the said provisions of the said recited Acts respectively shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

5. And be it enacted That from and after the passing of this Act all Justices of the Peace for the Territory of New South Wales shall have jurisdiction within the limits of the Town of Melbourne anything in the said recited Acts to the contrary notwithstanding.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

Schedule.

South Melbourne—Bounded on the east by the continuation of the eastern boundary of North Melbourne bearing south one hundred and twenty-six chains and a half a chain on the south by a line bearing west to Hobson's Bay one hundred and twenty-five chains and by Hobson's Bay to the point where the prolongation of the western boundary line of North Melbourne would meet eighty-five chains on the west by this line bearing north to the Yarra Yarra one hundred and eleven chains and on the north by the Yarra Yarra to the point of commencement.
