WHEREAS an Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of Preamble.
New South Wales was passed in the ninth year of the reign of
Her present Majesty intituled “*An Act to amend the Acts now in force* 9 Vic. No. 26;
“*respecting the Distillation of Spirits and more effectually to prevent*
“*Illicit Distillation*” which said Act will expire on the thirty-first
day of December now next ensuing. And whereas it is expedient to
continue the same for the limited period hereinafter mentioned. Be it continued for five

with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That
the said recited Act shall be and the same is hereby continued for the
period of five years from and after the said thirty-first day of December
now next ensuing.
