An Act to allow the importation of Borax and Saltpetre free of Duty. [25th July, 1849.]

IMPORTS FREE OF
DUTY.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Borax and Saltpetre imported into the Colony of New South Wales should be admitted free of duty Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That from and after the passing of this Act Borax and Saltpetre which shall be imported into the said Colony or entered inwards from the Bonded Warehouses thereof shall be duty free any thing contained in any Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
