An Act to allow the importation of Borax and Saltpetre IMPORTS FREE OF DUTY. [25th July, 1849.]

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Borax and Saltpetre Preamble. imported into the Colony of New South Wales should be admitted free of duty. Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That from and after the passing of this Act Borax and Saltpetre which shall be imported into the said Colony or entered Borax and Saltpetre to be free of duty. inwards from the Bonded Warehouses thereof shall be duty free anything contained in any Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
