MORETON BAY A

An Act to constitute Moreton Bay a Warehousing Port. [20th July, 1849.]

Preamble.

Moreton Bay to be a
Warehousing Port.

Chief Officer of Customs
may appoint
Warehouses

giving notice thereof
to the Governor for
his approval.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to constitute Moreton Bay a Warehousing Port for the Warehousing of goods imported in British ships or vessels Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof That from and after the first day of August next Moreton Bay shall be a Warehousing Port accordingly and that it shall be lawful for the Collector or other Chief Officer of Customs of the said Port by notice under his hand to appoint from time to time such Warehouse or Warehouses at said Port as shall be approved of by him for the warehousing and securing of goods therein for the purposes of this Act and subject to the law in that behalf which is now or shall hereafter be in force and also in such notice to declare what sort of goods may be warehoused and also by a like notice to revoke or alter any such appointment Provided always that every such notice shall be transmitted to the Governor of the said Colony and approved of by him before it can take effect.
