An Act to authorize the Chief Commissioner of Insolvent Estates to issue Certificates to Insolvents in certain cases. INSOLVENCY. [24th October, 1853.]

**W**HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the power of any Chief Commissioner of Insolvent Estates other than the Commissioner granting the same to issue a Certificate to an Insolvent under the sixteenth section of the Act passed in the seventh year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria numbered nineteen for amending the Insolvent Act And whereas it is expedient to remove such doubts Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Preamble.

of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Insolvents' Certificates may be issued by any Chief Commissioner.

1. Every Certificate to an Insolvent which has been heretofore or shall hereafter be granted by any Commissioner of Insolvent Estates shall or lawfully may at any time after confirmation by the Court be issued by any Chief Commissioner subsequently holding that office with such alteration in the form thereof as the fact of a different Commissioner signing and sealing the same may require and every Certificate so issued shall be as valid for all purposes as if the same had been signed and sealed in due form by the Commissioner who actually granted the same.
