

No. VI.GUNPOWDER.**An Act further to amend the Act for better regulating the keeping and carriage of Gunpowder. [14th August, 1855.]****Preamble.**

WHEREAS by the Act of Council five Victoria number eleven it is amongst other things enacted in the fourth section thereof that no Gunpowder shall be landed from the Government Magazine in any part of the Harbour of Port Jackson other than at the Queen's Wharf or at any time other than between the hours of six and ten in the morning which said enactment was by the Act of Council sixteen Victoria number forty-seven applied to the Gunpowder stored in the Colonial Magazine at Goat Island And whereas the wharf formerly called the Queen's Wharf has now become part of the Circular Quay and it is not expedient that Gunpowder should be permitted to be landed at the said quay Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Sec. 4 of 5 Vic. No. 11 repealed and new regulation in lieu thereof.

The fourth section of the said first recited Act shall be and is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof it is enacted that subject to the proviso in that Act contained no Gunpowder shall be landed from any Gunpowder Magazine in any part of the Harbour of Port Jackson other than at the Point near Dawes' Battery nor at any time other than between the hours of six and ten in the morning and any person who shall land or attempt to land any Gunpowder contrary to the provisions hereof shall forfeit and pay the sum of two shillings for every pound of Gunpowder so landed or attempted to be landed.
