An Act to apply to Newcastle and to other Ports SEAMEN'S LODGINGS.
as occasion may require the provisions of the
Water Police Regulation Act of 1853 respect-
ing Seamen's Lodging-houses. [22nd August,
1855.]

WHEREAS from the great increase of Shipping at the Port of Preamble.
Newcastle it has become expedient to extend to that port the
provisions respecting Seamen's Lodging-houses contained in the Act
of Council seventeen Victoria number thirty-six. And whereas it may ^{17 Vic. No. 36.}
also become expedient to extend the same provisions to other ports of
increasing trade Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor
of New South Wales with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council thereof as follows:—

1. From and after the first day of January now next the provisions Provisions in 17
Vic. No. 36
respecting Seamen's
Lodging-houses
extended to New-
castle.
contained in the thirty-first to the thirty-eighth sections both inclusive
of the said recited Act shall be applied to and within the City of New-
castle and the neighbourhood thereof in the same manner and to all
intents and purposes as if the said City and neighbourhood had been
expressly mentioned in the said several sections of the said Act.

2. Whenever it shall appear to the Governor with the advice Such provisions may
be extended to other
ports by orders of
the Governor and
Executive Council.
of His Executive Council expedient to extend the said provisions to
any other port or place much resorted to by shipping and seamen it
shall be lawful for the said Governor by notification in the *New South
Wales Government Gazette* to declare such port or place and the
neighbourhood thereof to be within the said provisions and thereupon
the same shall apply to and within the said port or place and the
neighbourhood thereof in the same manner to all intents and purposes
as if the said port or place and neighbourhood had been expressly
mentioned in the said sections of the said recited Act.
