GUNPOWDER.

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue for a further limited time Preamble.
the Act of Council passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's

Warlike Stores subject to the restriction thereof to such Gunpowder
and Warlike Stores and such vessels as may be shipped and cleared
out for New Zealand as provided by the Act of Council number twenty 17 Vic. No. 20.
of the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's reign Be it therefore enacted
by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales by and with the

1. The said Act shall be and is hereby continued from the 9 Vic. No. 6 con-
