An Act for amending the Law relative to Larceny
by Carriers and other Bailees. [27th August,
1858.]

LARCENY BY
BAILEES.
—

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Law relative to Larceny by Carriers and other Bailees Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

Scab in Sheep.

Bailees fraudulently
converting goods to
their own use guilty
of larceny.

14 Vic. No. 6 re-
pealed.

1. If any person being a Bailee of goods or chattels shall with intent to defraud convert such goods or chattels or any part thereof to his own use or the use of any person other than the owner thereof he shall be guilty of larceny.

2. The Act fourteenth Victoria number six intituled "*An Act to prevent frauds by Carriers and Drovers*" is hereby repealed except so far as relates to any offence against the provisions of that Act committed before the passing of the present Act.
