TOBACCO DUTIES. An Act to alter the Duties of Customs payable
on Tobacco. [30th December, 1861.]

Preamble. **W**HEREAS it is expedient to alter the duties imposed by the
“ Customs Duties Act of 1855 ” on imported Tobacco Be it
therefore enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty by and with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the
authority of the same as follows :—

Murray River Customs.

1. So much of the “ Customs Duties Act of 1855 ” and of the Schedule thereto as imposes an uniform duty of two shillings the pound on Tobacco and Snuff is hereby repealed.

Partial repeal of 19 Vic. No. 14.
2. There shall be payable on Tobacco Cigars and Snuff imported into New South Wales the several duties of Customs mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

Duties on Tobacco.
3. This Act shall commence on the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two and shall be styled and may be cited as the “ Tobacco Duties Act of 1861.”
