An Act to apply certain Sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales towards the Service of the Year 1868. [*1st February, 1868.*]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Two hundred and twenty-eight thousand two hundred and eighteen pounds six shillings and ten-pence being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the Colony from first January to twenty-ninth February one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Your Majesty Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supplies so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty for the service of the first two months of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight commencing on the first day of January and ending on the twenty-ninth day of February in the said year the sum of Two hundred and twenty-eight thousand two hundred and eighteen pounds six shillings and ten-pence. £228,218 6s. 10d.  
may be applied for  
first two months  
of 1868.

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer shall from time to time order and direct And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony. Treasurer to pay  
under Governor's  
Warrant or Order.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. Treasurer to have  
credit and receipts  
to discharge him.
