

No. XI.**An Act to amend the Impounding Act of 1865.** IMPOUNDING ACT
AMENDMENT.
[30th March, 1869.]

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the meaning of the words Preamble.
 “competent Court” in the Impounding Act of 1865 and
 it is expedient to remove such doubts Be it therefore enacted by the
 Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent
 of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
 Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as
 follows :—

1. Whenever the words “competent Court” shall be found in Meaning of “com-
petent Court.”
 the said recited Act such words shall be held to mean any two or
 more Justices assembled at a Court of Petty Sessions.

2. This Act may be cited as the “Impounding Act Amend- Short title.
 ment Act of 1869.”
