**W**HEREAS it is expedient to continue for a further period of one Preamble.  
year from and after the thirty-first day of December one  
thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine the Acts twenty-nine Victoria  
number six and thirty-one Victoria number twenty-six Be it therefore  
enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice  
and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of  
New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of  
the same as follows :—

1. The Act twenty-nine Victoria number six being the *Stamp* Stamp Duties Act  
of 1865 and Act to  
amend the Stamp  
Duties Act of 1865  
continued.  
*Duties Act of 1865* and the Act thirty-one Victoria number twenty-six  
intituled “*An Act to amend the Stamp Duties Act of 1865*” shall  
continue and remain in force until the thirty-first day of December  
one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

2. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the “Stamp Duties Short title.  
Acts Continuation Act of 1869.”
