STAMP DUTIES ACTS
CONTINUATION. An Act to continue “The Stamp Duties Act of 1865” and the Act intituled “*An Act to amend the Stamp Duties Act of 1865.*” [29th March, 1871.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue for a further period of two months from and after the thirty-first day of March one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one the Acts twenty-nine Victoria number six and thirty-one Victoria number twenty-six Be it therefore enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Act twenty-nine Victoria number six being “*The Stamp Duties Act of 1865*” and the Act thirty-one Victoria number twenty-six intituled “*An Act to amend the Stamp Duties Act of 1865*” shall continue and remain in force until the thirty-first day of May one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one.

2. This Act may be cited as the “Stamp Duties Acts Continuation Act of 1871.”
