

CONSOLIDATED
REVENUE FUND

An Act to apply a certain Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales towards the Service of the Year 1873. [20th November, 1873.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the further sum of Thirty thousand pounds towards the Expenses and Services of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three
And

Friendly Societies.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Your Majesty Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales £30,000 may be applied for Services of 1873. there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty towards the Services of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three the further sum of Thirty thousand pounds—

To enable the Treasurer to make Advances to Public Officers and on account of other Governments and to pay Expenses of an unforeseen nature which will afterwards be submitted for Parliamentary appropriation—the whole amount to be adjusted not later than the thirty-first December one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four.

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the service aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
