DUTY ON GOLD
ABOLITION.

An Act for the abolition of the Duty on Gold. [15th July, 1879.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to abolish the duty on Gold Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

Duty on Gold abolished
and Acts 20 Vic. No. 17
and 26 Vic. No. 5
repealed.

1. The duty on Gold payable by virtue of the Acts twenty Victoriae number seventeen and twenty-six Victoriae number five is hereby abolished and the said Acts are hereby repealed.

When to take effect.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of October one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine.
