An Act to amend the “Sydney Corporation Act of 1879” in certain particulars. [20th May, 1880.]

SYDNEY
CORPORATION ACT
AMENDMENT (No. 3).

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the “Sydney Corporation Act of 1879” in certain particulars Be it therefore enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the “Sydney Corporation Act Amendment Act 1880” and its provisions shall be read with and as forming part of the said “Sydney Corporation Act of 1879.”

Short title and
construction of Act.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the “Sydney Corporation Act of 1879” any person who shall feel dissatisfied with the determination of a Judge of the District Court as to the principle upon which any assessment as confirmed or altered by such Judge was made may appeal from such determination to the Supreme Court Provided that notice in writing of such intended appeal to the Supreme Court shall in all cases of appeal from a determination of the District Court Judge given before the passing of this Act be lodged within fourteen days after the passing of this Act and in all cases of appeal from

from a determination given after the passing of this Act a like notice shall be lodged within fourteen days after such determination And the Supreme Court may make such order in the matter of the appeal as to the said Court may seem just which order if directed to the Registrar of the District Court shall be carried out by him.

Application of
District Court Act
and Rules.

3. The provisions of the "District Court Act of 1858" except so far as the right of appeal is thereby made to depend on the amount claimed and the general rules thereunder in force for the time being relating to appeals to the Supreme Court shall subject to the provisions of this Act govern and regulate all appeals permitted by this Act.
