An Act to grant to the Municipalities of the Colony other than the Municipal Council of Sydney a Special Endowment extending over Twelve Calendar months. [12th July, 1880.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Special Endowment
to be granted.

1. It shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to pay out of the Consolidated Revenue to each of the Municipalities established under the Act thirty-first Victoria number twelve as a Special Endowment for the twelve calendar months ending on the third day of February one

one thousand eight hundred and eighty a sum of money equal to one-half of the total amount of the rates levied and collected by such Municipality for said twelve calendar months. And every such payment shall be made on the footing of the accounts and in accordance with the provisions prescribed by the one hundred and eighty-ninth section of the said first mentioned Act.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Municipalities Special short title. Endowment Act for 1880."
