MINING ACT  
FURTHER AMEND-  
MENT.

### An Act to further amend the Act 37 Victoria No. 13. [21st November, 1882.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the security of applications made under the "Mining Act 1874" for leases of land for Mining purposes Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Application for leases  
and possession.

1. To obtain a lease for mining purposes of any kind provided for in the Act thirty-seven Victoria number thirteen possession of the land shall be taken and application to lease made in the manner form and period prescribed by the regulations made under the said Act Every portion of land open to lease of which possession shall have been taken as aforesaid shall be deemed to be held under promise of lease and to be exempt from sale unless or until default has occurred in making the prescribed application to lease or until the application has been abandoned or the Governor has refused the application and notice of such abandonment or refusal has been published in the *Gazette*.
