An Act to increase the Pensions payable to retired Judges of the Supreme Court now in the receipt of Pensions. [27th April, 1883.]

RETIRED JUDGES'
PENSIONS.

WHEREAS it is expedient to increase the Pensions payable to retired Judges of the Supreme Court now in the receipt of Pensions Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Preamble.

1. From the passing of this Act the pensions to which retired Judges of the Supreme Court now in the receipt of pensions shall be entitled and which shall be payable to them shall be seven-tenths of the salaries actually received by them at the respective dates of their retirement And such pensions shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.
