An Act to amend the “Civil Service Act, 1884,  
in respect of Classification and Increases.”  
[25th October, 1886.]

BE it enacted by the Queen’s Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the “Civil Service Act Amendment Act 1886.”

Repeal of classifica-  
tion and increases  
in Act of 1884.

2. So much of the “Civil Service Act 1884” as prescribes a Classification of all Officers within Divisions and so much of the said Act as entitles such Officers to Increases based on such Classification are hereby repealed. The repeal hereby enacted shall take effect on and after the first day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven and not before.
